Program Support Highlights

Expanding Access and Equity: During the pandemic the Marin County Library Foundation ramped up efforts to assist Marin's most economically vulnerable residents. Our efforts included supporting access to WiFi hotspots, Learning Hubs, Book Bistro/book giveaway programs, and summertime Learn At Home Kits.

To increase educational equity, we helped the library and schools issue 800 WiFi hotspots during the pandemic to benefit youth in neighborhoods lacking internet access for homework and attending online classes.

Thank you for your support and contributions toward raising over \$200,000 for WiFi hotspots and increased educational equity.


Opportunities for Support
