- 1 If you need a recycling bin to help the environment, call the **Environmental Health Services** (415-473-6907)
- 2 If there's a fire that's nearby, call the **Fire Department** (911 for emergencies only)
- 3 If you're having trouble biking in your neighborhood because there are a lot of potholes, call the **Department of Public Works** (415-473-7388)
- 4 If a swing set is broken at your favorite local park, call **Parks and Recreation** (415-473-6387)
- 5 If you want to borrow books, audiobooks, video games, magazines, DVDs, and more, call the **Marin County Free Library**: (415-473-6057)
- 6 If you're new to the area and need to register for school, call the **Marin County Office of Education**: (415-472-4110)

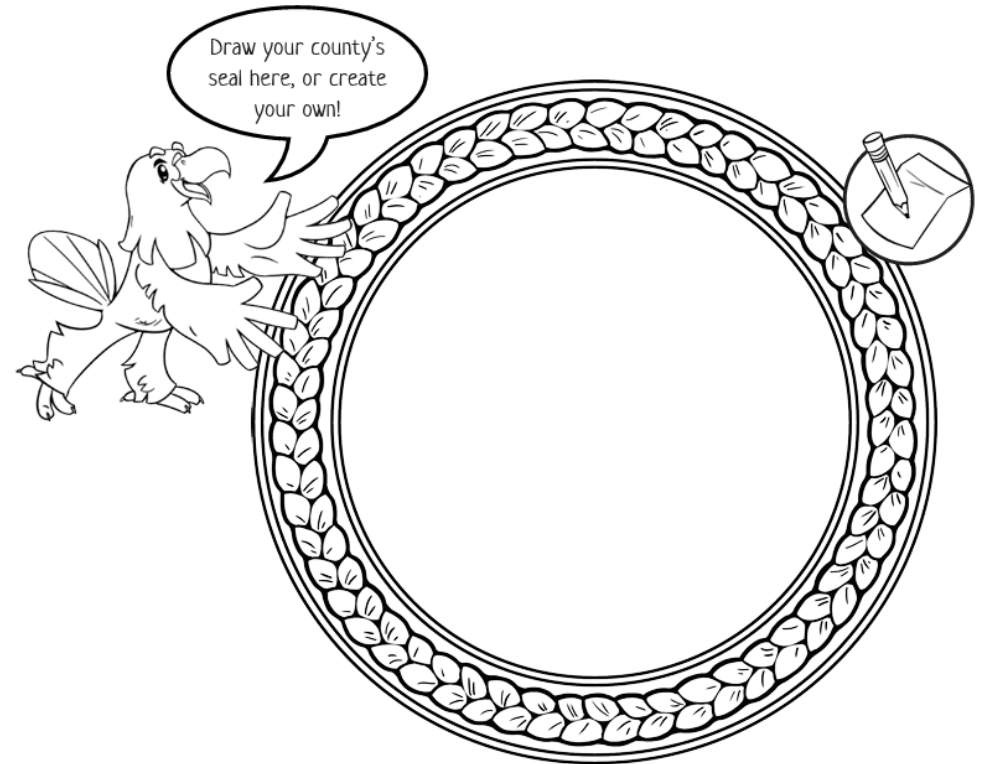

THE COUNTY SEAL

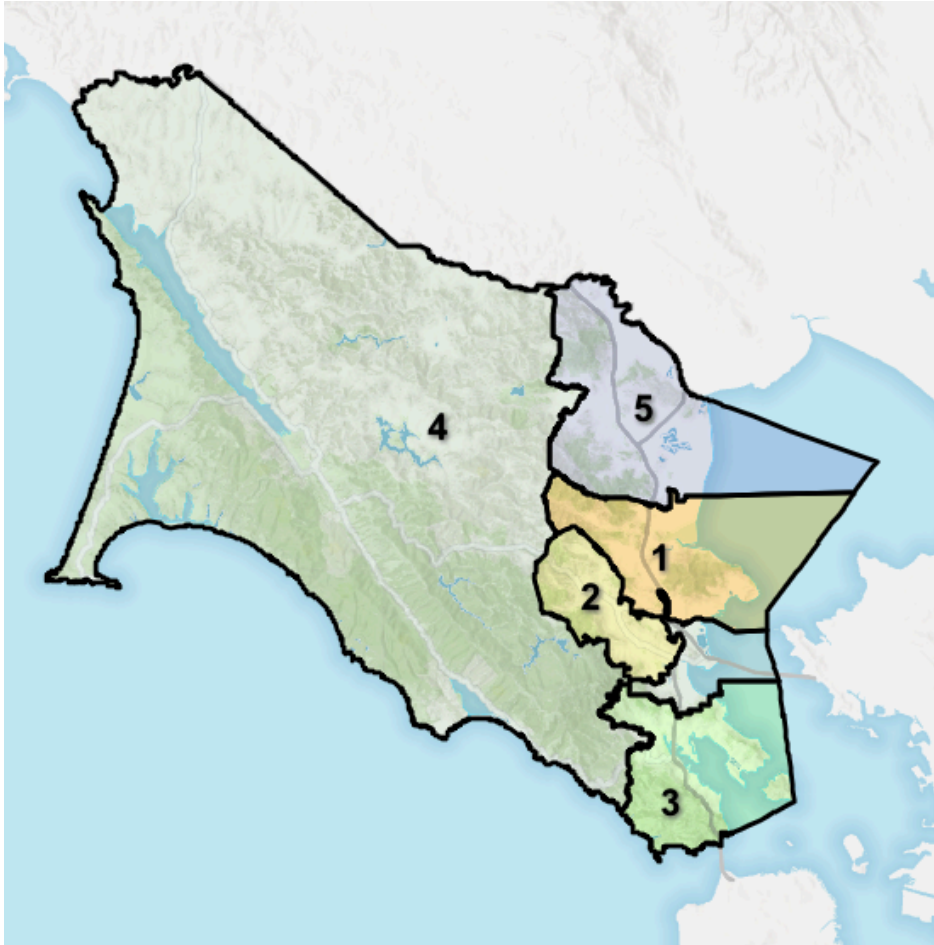


There are 3,069 unique counties across the United States, and each has a unique seal. A symbol is a special picture that represents a county and its people.

District 2: Brian Colbert: Fairfax, San Anselmo, Ross, Larkspur, SW San Rafael, Kentfield, Oak Manor, Greenbrae and Sleepy Hallow.



District 3: Stephanie Moulton-Peters: Sausalito, Marin City, Tam Valley, Almonte, Mill Valley, Strawberry, Tiburon, and Belvedere.



District 4: Dennis Rodoni: Coastal West Marin including: Nicasio, Chileno Valley, San Geronimo Valley, and W Novato.



District 5: Eric Lucan: Novato, Bel Marin Keys, Loma Verde, Black Point, Green Point, and Indian Valley.
