

APPLICATION FOR MARIN COUNTY FREE LIBRARY ACCESSIBLE WORKSTATION

Marin County Free Library offers a computer workstation with assistive software and devices at all regional branches (Civic Center, Corte Madera, Fairfax, Novato) and some smaller branches (Marin City, Point Reyes, South Novato) to help provide online access to persons with vision or mobility issues. Each station is equipped with a large monitor, a special keyboard, a variety of pointing devices and software such as ZoomText to magnify text.

Anyone may use an available Accessible Workstation but patrons with a verified disability qualify for special privileges such as reservations by phone and next-session priority for drop-in use.

To qualify for Accessible Workstation privileges, patrons must fill out this application and provide:

- a current MARINet library card and
- a verified proof of disability

Proof of disability may be a disabled parking placard, a disabled transit pass or a letter on official letterhead from a doctor, social worker, registered nurse, psychologist or learning disabilities/rehabilitation/special education teacher.

After an application is approved by a Branch Manager, patrons are encouraged to make advance reservations by phone (up to a maximum of 2 hours daily use).

For an individual with a temporary disability, Accessible Workstation privileges expire when the temporary disability ends.
